#### Rabbi's Message

Dear friends,

Tonight we celebrate the 121st anniversary of Congregation Anshe Sholom. Our theme for the evening is לא עליך המלאכה לגמור ולא אתה בן חורין לבטל ממנה , "It is not for you to complete the task, but neither are you free to desist from it (Avot 2:21)." The task of sustaining Jewish communal life is never truly finished. Time marches on, the community evolves, and new challenges must be faced to keep the flame of Judaism going strong. Tonight we honor Constance & James Levi for their years of dedication to Anshe Sholom. Constance served a long term on the synagogue Board and she has been a leading figure in the shul's Chesed activities. We also honor Dr. Aviva & Michael Berkowitz for leading the movement of young families into our neighborhood. The demographic trend they initiated has revitalized our shul. Our honorees are from different generations, but share a common purpose of rebuilding traditional Jewish life in New Rochelle.

When I look back at the past year of synagogue activities, I am encouraged by the progress we have made. This was by far the most successful year during my tenure as rabbi with regard to increasing membership. We have newcomers in their 20s and 30s as well as 60s and 70s. We have enhanced our diversity with respect to both age and level of religious observance, all while maintaining the accustomed level of comradery and warmth. Our Friday night minyan is stronger than ever, and we now hold it upstairs in the main sanctuary. Our Shabbat afternoon service has become very popular, especially the Q & A at Seudah Shlishit. We recently started a weekly class on Medical Halachah, held before services on Shabbat morning. There is a palpable sense of renewed interest in Torah study throughout the congregation.





Sometimes it is difficult to notice the changes as they are happening, especially if one is in shul every day or every week. I am gratified when a guest who attends on an infrequent basis comes over to me and remarks how pleasantly surprised they are to see the shul so crowded and full of life. Having many kids run around certainly is a blessing.

In the year ahead, I look forward to the strengthening of our daily minyan, increased participation in our Chesed activities, membership growth, and most importantly spiritual fulfillment for our congregants.

Sari and I salute the honorees and hope that all in attendance enjoy the evening.

#### President's Message

Fifty years ago today, June 11th 1967, the Jewish people woke up to a new reality. The Six Day War had concluded the day before with little Israel quadrupling in size in a mere 6 days. The heart of our happiness was in Jerusalem. For the first time since Israel's independence in 1948, Jewish people could visit the Western Wall, *HaKotel haMaaravi*. And for the first time in almost 2,000 years, all of Jerusalem was truly in Jewish hands.

Jerusalem...the heart of the Jewish people. Jerusalem, a multifaceted city of ancient and modern; young and old; religious and secular; Jews and non-Jews; Ashkenazi and Sephardi; rich and poor; a holy mosaic of peoples and cultures.

Jerusalem is very important to me. My personal history is in Jerusalem. My parents met in Jerusalem and I was born there. I spent many holidays and vacations in Jerusalem and when I moved to Israel after high school, Jerusalem officially became my home. When walking the streets of Jerusalem, I felt my own personal history and that of the Jewish people with every step. I know the restaurant my father enjoyed eating at while in the army and the location of the many apartments my mother lived in during her tenure in Jerusalem. Every stone in the city is dear to me as it has been for all over the millennia.

Le'havdil be'elef-alfei havdalot, in no way does New Rochelle compare to the centrality of Jerusalem for the Jewish people, but when I walk the streets of New Rochelle, or more often drive around the city, my family's long connection to the Queen City of the Sound is always on my mind. Congregation Anshe Sholom has been central to my family for over fifty years. Rabbi Weinberger married my parents and my birth was celebrated with a kiddush at the shul, even though I was in Jerusalem, having been born at Hadassah Hospital-Mount Scopus. Growing up, I spent many Shabbatot and chagim at Anshe Sholom, but I was too much a child to perceive the true significance of the shul and community.

As my personal connection to Anshe Sholom has deepened and matured, I look at our community as a source of strength and light. Our congregants, like the residents of Jerusalem, come from many different backgrounds, many different

customs and cultures. Yet, we all come together on Shabbat and holidays, for good times and bad times as a community made up of friends and loved ones. Each and every member of Anshe Sholom brings his/her own unique strengths and gifts to our community and we are so grateful.

It is my distinct honor and pleasure to honor Constance and James Levi and Aviva and Michael Berkowitz at this year's annual testimonial dinner. Constance, James, Aviva and Michael's dedication to Anshe Sholom is evident to all who are blessed to know them. They each bring special qualities and talents to Team Anshe Sholom. Constance and James have been part of our community for almost 15 years, while Aviva and Michael moved to New Rochelle two years ago. Constance and James's grandchildren are celebrating with them tonight, while Aviva and Michael's daughter Maytal will be celebrating her first birthday in a couple of weeks. These couples are quite similar, however. Their dedication to our shul and to strengthening our community encourages engagement and participation in the glorious mosaic that is Anshe Sholom.

Constance, James, Aviva and Michael: thank you! Thank you for all you have done and, be'ezrat Hashem, what you will continue to do in the future. Thank you for accepting the honors of this evening so that our community can recognize your contributions together in joy.







#### **ANSHE SHOLOM 2017 HONOREES**

### Constance & James Levi

James and Constance both grew up in the Boston area. They were both raised in close-knit families that imparted to them a lifelong love of learning, volunteering, traveling, sailing and boating. James grew up in Newton, Massachusetts, attended Harvard, served as an officer in the Navy, and earned an MBA from Harvard Business School. After reading a book titled "Making Millions in Real Estate," he bought his first building and was hooked. He began his career at Smith Barney, setting up their Real Estate Department, after which he was recruited to do the same for Oppenheimer and Co. After nearly two decades with Oppenheimer, he went out on his own starting many businesses and finally retiring to manage his own personal investments. James grew up in a scouting family and was a second generation Eagle Scout - he has had a lifelong involvement with the scouts running his son's Cub Scout Packs and serving on the Westchester Putnam Council of Boy Scouts for over 35 years.

Constance grew up in Brookline, Massachusetts and graduated from Michigan State University in only 2 1/2 years. She has two Master's Degrees in Education. She retired early from the classroom to raise Jimmy, Andrew, Deanne, and Connie, and enjoys doing many of the same things with her grandchildren Brianna, CJ, Eli, Meira, Timothy, Rhiannon, Cooper, Chaim, Avigayil, Zoe, and



Devorah. Having enjoyed being a Brownie as a child, Constance has organized five different troops over 45 years of involvement for both the Girl Scouts and Cub Scouts. Always active in the Jewish community, Constance was an active member and volunteer at Larchmont Temple serving on many committees, and eventually serving as both Sisterhood President and on the Board of Trustees.

In 2003, the Levis were ready to put in a kosher kitchen and needed the guidance of an orthodox rabbi. Constance approached Rabbi Rosenzveig and that was the beginning of their relationship with Anshe Sholom. Constance was very appreciative of Rabbi Rosenzveig's outreaching and so they joined our Shul. Immediately, Constance volunteered and was put in charge of the Kristallnacht program.

Whenever help was needed, Constance was there; sometimes, quietly working behind the scenes and other times taking charge of a program. In 2003 she helped David Tantleff organize our Torah restoration project. She was then asked by Rabbi Rosenzveig to bring back the education committee, which she ran for two years. She was instrumental in establishing the monthly Sunday film series. For nine years she was a member of the Board of Trustees overseeing other endeavors. And, she is also involved in our Chesed Program.

Constance became active in Sisterhood. She was on the Sisterhood Board for over ten years and served as treasurer, membership chairman and in 2005 chaired the Sisterhood Dinner.

Aside from the positions that Constance has held, she is always the first to volunteer serving at Kiddush luncheons, and she and James always come early to events so that they can give much needed last minute help.

James has a different way of supporting Anshe Sholom: he attends events. He has often joked, "If you feed me, I will come."

Several years ago, when at a board meeting, Constance heard that we needed a new computer. This was not in the budget. So, Constance and James immediately not only made a donation of a new computer, but also had their computer tech come to install it.

Attending Shabbos services is the high point of Constance's week, and she returns home with renewed energy and Shabbos peace. The Levis have found a spiritual home here at Anshe Sholom, and feel enveloped by the care and friendship of so many of its members.

### Aviva & Michael Berkowitz

Aviva was born and raised in Brooklyn, NY. Post high school, she studied in Yeshivat Sha'alvim women's seminary and then attended Yeshiva University's Stern College and was a student of its honors program. Aviva received her doctorate in medicine from the Einstein College of Medicine. After graduating from medical school, she interned in general medicine at Montefiore New Rochelle and is now in her residency at Montefiore Bronx specializing in Radiation Oncology.

Michael is originally from Fairfield County, CT and grew up mostly in Wesley Hills/ Monsey, NY. He studied for two years at Yeshivat Har Etzion (GUSH) and then attended the Sy Syms School of Business at Yeshiva University where he focused on Marketing & Economics. Upon graduation, Michael worked as a commodities trader for a publicly traded NYC firm. After a few years on Wall Street, he began a luxury menswear company called Norwegian Wool which is now his main career focus.

Michael and Aviva have been active in the Jewish community and have played numerous leadership roles including positions in NCSY, the Lauder Foundation, Cong. Kehilas Bais Yehuda, the Yeshiva University Women's Organization and the Einstein Synagogue.

Michael and Aviva have a beautiful daughter Maytal.



Michael and Aviva met as undergraduate students while studying at Yeshiva University and married right before their graduations. After their wedding, they initially lived in Washington Heights and participated both in the Shenk and Mount Sinai communities. They then moved to the Einstein Housing buildings in the Pelham Parkway neighborhood in the Bronx and lived there for the next few years while Aviva pursued her medical school degree. During this time, they both came to love the Einstein community and became very active in the Einstein Synagogue. They particularly liked the idea of having just one shul where people from different backgrounds and levels of affiliation could come together and celebrate Shabbat, holidays, and life cycle events as one cohesive community. Michael and Aviva remarked: "It was refreshing to see people who would usually daven in different shuls, and perhaps even live in different communities, come together and now sit next to each other, getting along and focusing on the positive commonalities that make us one people."

In addition to the warmth and cohesiveness at Einstein, they also appreciated how it was a Synagogue that fostered a sense of getting everyone involved and encouraged taking active leadership roles. While some larger communities might limit the leadership positions to those who were older and more advanced in their careers, Einstein was comprised of only students and their spouses and thus "forced" all of the young couples and singles to roll up their sleeves and help lead services, run activities and programs, oversee fundraising campaigns, hire the rabbi and serve on the board. These sentiments stayed with them, and when they began to search for their next community, they wanted to find a place that was also warm, welcoming, inclusive, religiously inspiring and encourage participation and involvement from all of its members.

They first heard about Anshe Sholom and the south New Rochelle community when they attended a Chanukka event at Einstein where Rabbi Hoffman was the guest speaker. They very much enjoyed his speech and found it to be clear, interesting, insightful and quite relevant. At the end of his talk he spoke about his shul and how it had so many of the qualities we were searching for. So, they decided to come and visit for a Shabbat. They were graciously hosted by Constance and James Levi. Throughout Shabbat, they were most impressed by the members of Anshe Sholom and enjoyed eating the communal meals in the shul. After that Shabbos visit, Aviva and Michael left our Shul with a feeling that "this would be a great place to live."

The Rudin Trophy is given in memory of their beloved father, grandfather, great-grandfather and great-grandfather, a long distance runner for the Pastime Athletic Club in the Bronx between 1917 and 1923.



#### Samuel Rudin (1896-1975)

An avid long distance runner and civic leader, Samuel Rudin rose from humble beginnings on New York's Lower East Side to become one of New York's major builders and owners of real estate. Rudin joined the Pastime Athletic Club in the Bronx in 1917 while a student at City College and competed in long distance races, as a member of the Club, through 1923. In 1925, he founded the Rudin Management Company, a real estate firm which owns and manages many multi-story apartment houses and office buildings in Manhattan. Samuel Rudin was actively involved with many charitable organizations in New York City, including the United Jewish Appeal, City College Fund and the Boy Scouts of America. In 1967, he was awarded an honorary Doctor of Laws degree by Iona College in New Rochelle, New York. Today the Rudin family continues to play a major philanthropic role in New York City and is proud to have been a sponsor of the New York City Marathon since its inception as a five borough race in 1976.












