## FROM THE RABBI'S STUDY



Dear friends,

As you read this edition of the shul bulletin, I hope you are enjoying your summer vacation (wherever that might be). By the time this bulletin goes to print, I should be in sunny Miami Beach. Over the next weeks, we expect to see several young families moving into the neighborhood and joining our congregational family. In my absence, please give them a warm welcome. Our community continues to grow, and we have high hopes for the year ahead.

Over the summer months, I have three items on my agenda that I wish to share with you.

1) As an Executive Committee Member of the Westchester Board of Rabbis, I was tasked with spearheading the 2019 Night of Learning. Every two years, the Westchester Jewish Council arranges this event at which hundreds of Jews from all over the county study Torah with Westchester rabbis. We hope to have 500 participants listening to lectures delivered by 30 rabbis. The event will take place at Beth El Synagogue Center in New Rochelle on Saturday night, November 23<sup>rd</sup>. Doors open at 7:00PM. My own lecture will be on the topic of: "What Really Happens at a Jewish Funeral: The Rabbi's Perspective." If you have never previously attended a Night of Learning, I strongly urge you to do so. Aside from the tremendous opportunity for Torah study, there is a terrific sense of camaraderie in the building as Jews of all sorts gather in harmony.

2) I am already at work preparing next year's lecture series. As in past years, the lectures are delivered at Anshe Sholom on Monday nights at 7:00PM, and then repeated on Tuesday nights in Woodmere (where the lecture is recorded and made available on [www.yutorah.org](http://www.yutorah.org)). For 2019-2020 the topic will be "History of Zionism 1881-1947." The upcoming series is actually the prequel to this year's lectures on Israeli Political History. I hope some of you will join our Monday night group as we delve into the lives of Kalischer, Pinsker, Herzl, Nordau, Jabotinsky, Weizmann, Ben-Gurion, and Stern.

3) Over the next few months, I will be researching and writing the last batch of my "Thoughts on the Parashah" essays. I am nearing the end of my eighth year of writing, and it is long overdue for me to give up the weekly essay and focus on other projects. It has been a long intellectual journey, and I want to thank everyone who sponsored essays or engaged me in discussion on the hundreds of topics we covered. My goal for the coming year is to edit my writings

and publish a book of essays covering all of the weekly Parshiyot and the Jewish holidays. Putting aside the burnout experienced by anyone who tries to be a prolific writer, the other reason for putting down my pen is so that I will have the time to finally complete my critical study of the Mishnah and all its primary commentaries.

We hope to have several more sessions of Perek on the Lawn in late July and August. Please let me know if you would like to host.

## A TORAH MINUTE

The praise of the holiness of G-d, is triple, as it says "Holy, Holy, Holy". As a result, the Jewish people also need to complete themselves with three types of holiness, that of thought, speech and action.

While a person is able to sanctify himself in action, sanctifying himself in speech is more difficult on account of the *Yetzer Ha'ra* (evil inclination). And if a person manages to overcome it and sanctifies himself in speech, sanctifying himself in thought is much more difficult, because the *Yetzer Ha'ra* stands in the way.

In the future, however, the *Yetzer Ha'ra* will become purified, and the verse in Isaiah "And Your people are all righteous", will be fulfilled. Then the Jewish people will be praised with a triple praise, that of thought, speech and action, in the same way that the Holy One Blessed be He is praised with a triple praise.

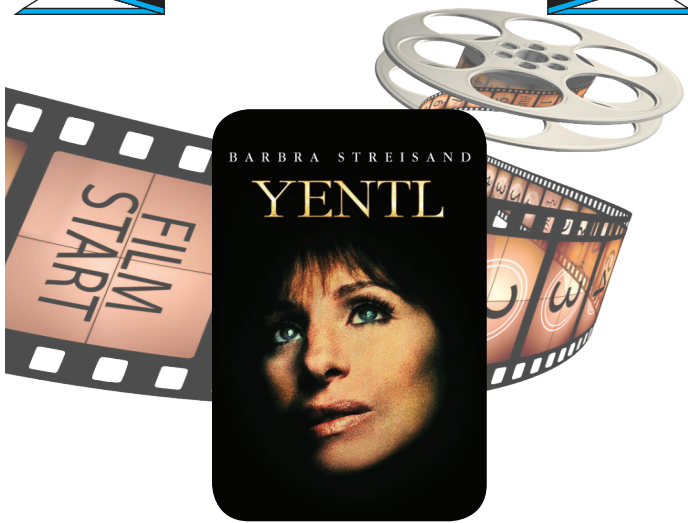

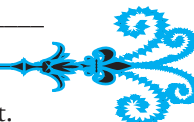
